## **About Institute**

The Narayan Meghaji Lokhande Maharashtra Institute of Labour Studies was established in July 1947 in Mumbai by Bharatratna Shri Gulzarilalji Nanda and the Minister of Labour, Mumbai, as a school for training of labour welfare workers. It is a unique institute, one of its kind in the field of labour studies.

Previously known as "Regional Labour Institute (RLI) Nagpur," it came into existence in 1971 as a branch of the Narayan Meghaji Lokhande Maharashtra Institute of Labour Studies (NML MILS) and, as of February 1, 2023, has been renamed "N.M. Lokhande Maharashtra Institute of Labour Studies Nagpur" to deliver the same proficiency to future human resource, industrial relations, and personnel management professionals at the regional level.

Beginning with a nine-month diploma for union leaders, it was expanded in 1983 to a two-year full-time postgraduate diploma in Labour Studies. With the increasing complexities of modern industrial work and life, the whole perspective of labour welfare widened considerably, and it became necessary to nationalise and tone up the training programme, enabling the trainees to deliver their duties and responsibilities, particularly in the fields of labour welfare, industrial relations, and personnel management. With this view in mind, the Diploma in Labour Studies (D.L.S.) was upgraded and replaced by the 2-year post-graduate degree course, the Master of Labour Studies (MLS) to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University. With the implementation of the New Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the course has been renamed as Master of Human Capital Management & Employee Relations (MHCM & ER) from the 2023 -2024.

## **Orientation of the Batch 2024-26**







MHCM & ER Part-II students took the initiative to give Part-I students an introduction as part of the orientation for Batch 2024–26, introducing them to the various subjects they will be studying during their Semester I. Below is a synopsis of each topic:

#### Semester I

- > <u>Labour Economics:</u> Labour Economics examines the dynamics between workers and employers in labour markets. It explores the determinants of employment, wages, and working conditions, integrating theories of supply and demand, human capital, and labour market policies. This subject provides insights into how economic forces and policies shape labour markets and impact societal welfare.
- <u>Business Management Science</u>: Business management science focuses on applying quantitative and analytical methods to solve complex business problems. It encompasses various disciplines such as operations research, statistics, and decision analysis to enhance decision-making and strategic planning. This subject equips students with the skills to optimize business processes, improve efficiency, and drive data-informed decisions.
- Labour Legislation I: Labour Legislation delves into the laws and regulations governing employment relationships and workers' rights. It covers various statutes and legal frameworks related to safety, welfare and health of workers, their wages and social security benefits like Provident Fund, ESI benefits, Gratuity, etc.
- > <u>Field Work I:</u> The field Work exposure provides opportunity for real world life experience to the students regarding theories and practices learnt in classroom. The course includes observation visits to different industrial sector organizations. Also visits to Civic Administration Office/s, Employee State Insurance Corporation.
- Research Methodology: Research Methodology subject provides an understanding of research methodology, process, ethics in research and research approaches applied to problems of business environment. The knowledge of social research methodologies includes both Quantitative and Qualitative designs to organize and conduct research in a scientific way. The subject also covers report writing in detail. It deals with scientific methodology for applied research and the use of statistics for hypothesis testing.

### Electives:

- Managerial Economics: Managerial Economics applies economic principles to management decision-making, enabling the analysis of business strategies, demand forecasting, cost analysis, and pricing strategies. It equips managers with the tools to optimize operations and enhance profitability.
- <u>Industrial Economics:</u> Industrial Economics studies the structure, behaviour, and performance of industries and firms, focusing on market competition, regulation, and strategic business decisions. It provides insights into how industries operate and the economic forces influencing firm behaviour and market outcomes.

## **Assessment & Development Centre**

At the NML MILS Nagpur Assessment Centre, a comprehensive approach to evaluating students' competencies has been established. The assessment process is meticulously designed to gauge the following key competencies:

**Conceptual Clarity:** The ability to grasp and articulate complex concepts is assessed through various interactive activities.

**Decision Making Skills:** Candidates' aptitude for making effective decisions, considering multiple factors, is evaluated through simulated scenarios.

**Ability to Analyse and Solve Business Problems:** Students' capacity to dissect and solve intricate business problems is tested using real-world case studies.

**Communication Skills:** The proficiency to convey ideas clearly and convincingly is measured through both written and verbal tasks.

**Ability to Work Independently and in Teams:** The capacity to function autonomously and collaborate effectively within teams is assessed via diverse group exercises.

### To ensure a thorough evaluation, the assessment process is structured as follows:

**Jenga Box Game - Individual and Group**: Candidates partake in the enga Box game individually and in groups. This activity assesses both independent decision-making and collaboration within a team.

**Role Play with Assessor**: Candidates engage in role-playing scenarios, where their ability to apply conceptual knowledge and make decisions is evaluated. The assessor also gauges their communication and problem-solving skills during this exercise.

**Behavioural Event Interview:** Each candidate undergoes a Behavioural Event Interview (BEI), where they share instances from their experiences that highlight the competencies being evaluated. The assessor asks probing questions to gauge their decision-making, problem-solving, and teamwork skills.

**Feedback Session:** Following the assessment activities, candidates receive personalized feedback from assessors. This session aids in self-awareness and guides students on areas of improvement.

The NML MILS Nagpur Assessment Centre employs this comprehensive process to ensure a holistic evaluation of students' competencies. It enables the identification of strengths and areas for development, providing valuable feedback.
